

What is a K4J Captain?

The **Captain Leadership** program involves children in **Grade 3 & 4** to become “teachers of virtue,” by hosting the monthly assemblies, at the same time transforming the way they and the younger children live their faith.

Captains get to be creative by deciding and taking turns with the parts in the skit, preparing the props and costumes.

What do you do with the K4J Send it Home Packs?

K4J Send-It-Home packs help kids practice the virtue “Mission of the Month” at home! These packs come in three different age-levels: pre-K4J for 4 & 5 year olds, Grades 1 & 2 and the Grades 3 & 4 Captains.

Each age group receives a different, age-level Mission “card” and a Parents’ Perspective letter, as well as other surprises that help kids live and track their virtue mission all month long.

Parents are encouraged to help their children complete the virtue activity card each month so they bring them in to receive a certificate and prize.



Why do we need parents and parishioners to get involved?

K4J Volunteers have the opportunity to participate in a worthwhile activity at the same time counting as a steward to the Church.

Volunteer Leaders help children by teaching them about their faith with other kids in group settings and about virtues through crafts, songs, games, snacks, catechesis and the Grade 3 & 4 Captains Assembly.

The K4J Program can only function with our parent & parishioner volunteer participation. We totally rely on our volunteers to prepare, lead, teach and/ or assist at every class.

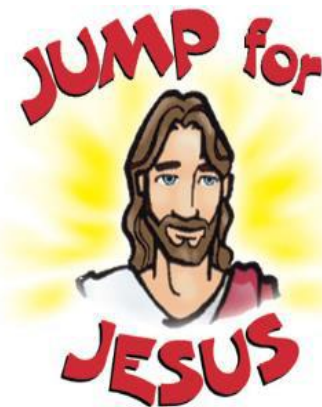
